Dear Parents:

Spencer County Schools has been identified for improvement under No Child Left Behind (NCLB). According to the NCLB Report released by the Kentucky Department of Education (KDE), Spencer County Schools reached 11 out of 13 target goals (84.6%) but did not make AYP (adequate yearly progress) with our special education students in reading and math. Under the federal law, a district that does not meet adequate yearly progress for two years in a row is identified for improvement. When a district is identified for improvement, it is required to revise its comprehensive district improvement plan. The purpose of the plan is to improve student achievement throughout the district. Therefore, the plan overall must identify actions that have the greatest likelihood of accomplishing this goal. The plan must include strategies to promote effective parental involvement in the schools served by the district. You are encouraged to become involved in your child's school and become an active partner with teachers and school and district administration in educating your children.
